

How to use Spanish decodable texts in your classroom:

These Spanish decodable texts are excellent to use in your reading small groups. They support students in getting the practice they need to become better readers. Follow these simple steps to get the most out of your decodable readers.

Step 1: Warm up (2-3 min) Activate the sound

Teacher:

- Says: "Hoy vamos a leer con ----"
- Goes through quick phonemic awareness routine using the sounds.

Students:

- Repeat the sound/syllable (2-3 times)
- Tap or clap syllables

Step 2: Syllable Practice (3 min) Build automaticity

Teacher:

- Writes syllables on the board.
- Prompt: "¿Qué sílaba es?"
- Keeps pace fast and engaging

Students:

- Read in order and out of order
- Respond quickly to teacher pointing

Step 3: Word Building + Blending (4-5 min) Decode words

Teacher:

- Uses 2-3 words from the text
- Teacher models routine:
 - 1) Tap syllables
 - 2) Blend
 - 3) Read fluently

Students:

- Repeat word building + blending routine
- Can use flash cards, dry erase boards, sticky notes, tiles, word blending mats

Step 4: Decodable Reading (5-7 min) Apply skill in context (Most Important Part!)

Teacher:

- Prompts students as needed:
 - "¿Qué sílaba ves?"
 - "Júntalas"
 - "Léela otra vez"

Students:

- Read the decodable text

Step 5: Writing Connection (3-4 min) Connect reading and writing

Teacher:

- Guides students through dictation (dictado)
- Option A: 1-2 words
- Option B: 1-2 sentences
- Option C: 1-2 words + 1 sentence

Students:

- Write
- Read their sentence aloud

Step 6: Closure (1 min) Quick review

Teacher:

- Asks, "¿Qué aprendimos hoy?"

Students:

- Repeat syllables or skill

3) Staple on the folded side. (optional)
